June President's Update

JANE's event calendar has been ramping up, along with the weather, and membership participation is setting records not previously seen in the history of the club.

This year's Judges Training session was held on Sunday, May 15th, and sponsored by Jaguar Peabody, who graciously provided their service area for the display of four members' cars and training for the 18 judges. We were also treated to coffee and doughnuts to start the morning off, as well as a wonderful lunch midway through our event.

We really appreciate this level of support from one of the leading dealerships in our area.

The May monthly meeting with "Cars on the Lawn" at the Larz Anderson Auto Museum had 104 members in attendance (94 members for the dinner), providing 47 cars on display with everything from XK120s to F-Types. This was the largest attendance at a monthly meeting the club has ever had. The weather was ideal, and early attendees enjoyed vintage music, cheese, crackers, and grapes, all while mingling among the cars and telling tales of past histories and adventures. The main meal presented a wonderful variety of selections, followed by what seemed like a never-ending table of tasty desserts.

Following the meal, the next highlight of the evening was our guest speaker, John Elmgreen, from Australia. John has been involved in researching and keeping records of XKs for many years, and along with his writing and research partner, Terry McGrath, recently published their book entitled *The Jaguar XK120 in the Southern Hemisphere*. After much historical commentary, including some adventurous tales, John graciously allowed some time for a lengthy Q & A. Many thanks to Carl Hanson for making it possible for the club to have John as our guest speaker.

The next club record will be in the process of being set while this issue of the *Cat* is at the printer, when we will have 71 club members and 34 cars en route to Quebec City. This will be the largest driving event the club has ever had, and everyone is looking forward to having a great time. Ed Avis and Mark Lenci have put a tremendous amount of work into organizing this event, so watch for the event report in the July *Cat*.

The remaining weeks of June offer plenty more events, starting with the Second Annual British Motorcar Festival in Bristol, Rhode Island, from the 9th through the 12th. Just as the Festival is winding down on Sunday, the 12th, our sister club, JCSNE, will be holding their annual Concours at the Lyman Orchards in Middlefield, Connecticut. This will be an additional opportunity for anyone competing in either Champion or Driven classes to have their car judged and put them closer to the possibility of winning a Regional Award. Several of our JANE Judges will be traveling down to assist with the responsibilities. Closing out the month will be our monthly meeting at the Inn at Bay Pointe in Quincy, Massachusetts, on June 22nd, and then the following Saturday, June 25th, will be our Spring/Summer Slalom in North Andover, Massachusetts.

The Concours is only just a little more than two months away and we still need some help with the final details. This is our biggest and most important event of the year, and I encourage everyone to register early as well as volunteer during this fun-filled weekend. Our Concours Chair, Jane Murray, has most everything positioned






May Meeting at Larz Anderson Auto Museum




