



- 1. **Dates:** The event runs from Friday afternoon, October 21, to mid-morning Sunday, October 23.
- 2. Ferry Reservations: You will make your own reservations on the ferry from Woods Hole to Vine-yard Haven (508-477-8600 or www.steamshipauthority.com). Round trip fare for your Jaguar/car of choice is \$137. Round trip fare for you and your guest is \$17 per person. Select a time that meets your personal schedule ... early arrivals can enjoy shopping locally and snacks/drinks at the many fantastic establishments on the Vineyard. Remember that we will have our JANE Welcome Reception at the hotel at about 5 p.m. on Friday. Of course, we will have a list of local restaurants for you to try on Friday evening.
- 3. Hotel Reservations: Make your own reservations, with special rates at the elegant Harbor View Hotel in Edgartown. JANE has reserved a block of 20 rooms under "Jaguar Association of New England." To make your reservations, call 1-800-225-6005. You can choose a guestroom in the Main Building (standard king) at a rate of \$239 per night or in the adjacent Governor Mayhew (double double) at a rate of \$209 per night. There is a two-night minimum, but you may stay longer at those special rates if you wish. The cutoff date for our block of rooms is September 7, 2016.
- 4. **Island Driving Tour:** Saturday's schedule will feature a **guided driving tour** of the island, which will include stops at **famous historic sites**, with **welcome lectures** from Martha's Vineyard historians. The driving tour will **begin at 10 a.m.**, after your breakfast. A **fun lunch stop** will be scheduled. An afternoon **wine and cheese tasting** will again be held at a very **special art gallery**.

#### **SPRING SLALOM SUCCESS**

The first JANE slalom for 2016 was held under beautiful blue skies on Saturday, June 25. We had 17 participants running a wide assortment of current, classic, and specialty cars.

The Slalom Committee – Paul Bicknell, Glen McLachlan, and Rich Kosinski -- arrived at 9am and found several entrants already waiting by their cars to start their runs! We immediately started to set the course, started registrations by 9:30, and were ready to start the first runs soon after.

Although most of the entrants had run our course before, we did walk the course first, allowing a few of the newer participants (in their Hondas!) to familiarize themselves with the course and how to set a line around the cones.

After three runs, it was noon and time for a lunch break. This year we had a variety of sandwiches made from a local favorite deli – Borellis. We had a lot of comments as to how fresh and delicious the lunch was and that it was preferred to the food truck of prior years.

Reviewing the mid-race results showed that it was neck and neck between one of JANE's seasoned pros – Dennis Eklof in his Stalker, and a couple of Corvette owners, along with Bob Totten in his specially prepared Triumph. 



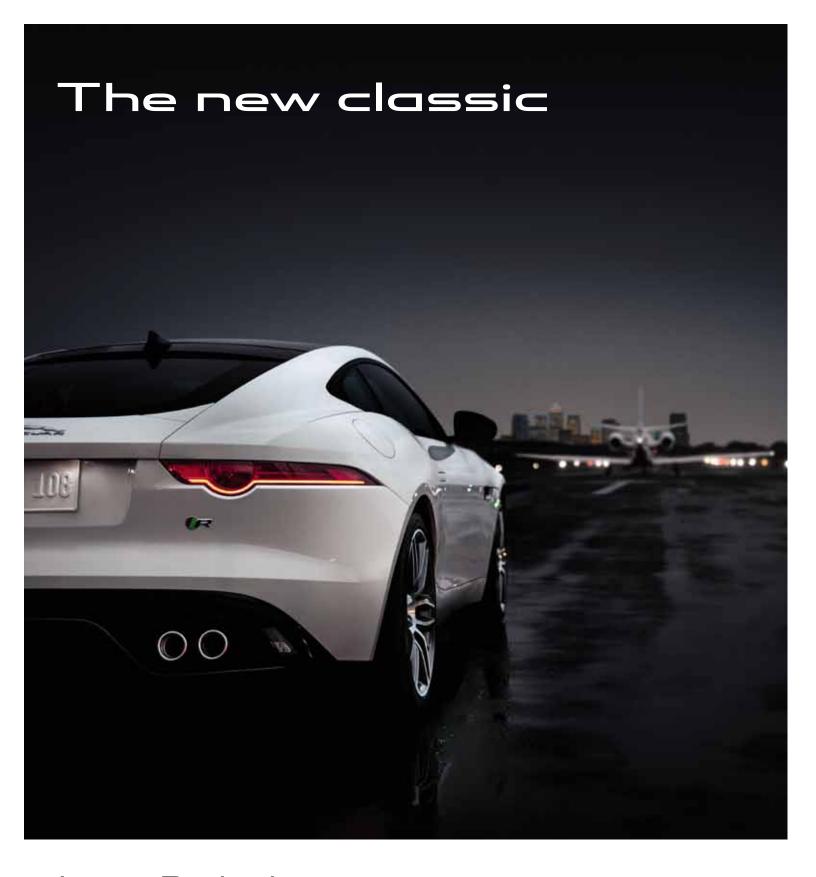
